CALL FOR ORAL PRESENTATIONS: ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- 1. We invite participants to submit abstracts on any and all aspects of tobacco control at any levels. Abstracts can be on research conducted, new developments in the field, policy perspectives or technical submissions.
- 2. Abstracts submitted should be original work that has not been published or submitted for consideration of publication.
- 3. Abstracts are to be less than 250 words long and submitted in the IMRAD format, along with the title, list of authors and affiliations, and appropriate keywords.
- 4. Only a limited number of abstracts will be selected for the oral presentation sessions by the Scientific Committee. Other accepted abstracts will be published in the ISBN-registered publication of the Conference Proceedings. The decision to accept, allow for oral presentation or reject abstracts is at the discretion of the Scientific Committee.
- 5. Abstract presenters are requested to register with the conference and pay the appropriate registration fee by the deadline to be included in the selection process. At least ONE author is required to have been registered with the conference to be included in the selection process.
- 6. Oral presentations will be presented 'virtually' during the designated session on Saturday 17th October 2020. Presenters will have 6 minutes to present orally and 3 minutes for questions from the Panel of Judges. The entire presentation will be over 'Zoom'.
- 7. Abstract submission can be made through the portal at bit.ly/NTCC2020
- 8. Closing date for abstract submission is 9 October 2020.
